

NJCAA National Wrestling Tournament finishes first round

Spokane, Wash. -- Northeastern Oklahoma A&M took the early lead (44.5 team points) as the first round of the 2014 National Junior College Athletic Association Wrestling Tournament wrapped up Friday, Feb. 28 at the Spokane Convention Center.

The second round of the tournament will begin at 6:30 p.m. Pacific Time. Live updates and information for each weight class are being posted to the Track Wrestling website at www.trackwrestling.com.

Rounding out the top five team standing after the first round, Northwest College is second with 37.5 team points, Clackamas Community College has 36.5 team points, North Idaho College has 29 team points and Neosho County Community College has 27.5 team points.

The NIC team is chasing its 15th national championship. The started off slow, but came on later in the morning for fourth place in team standings.

On Saturday, March 1, All-Americans will begin wrestling at 10:30 a.m. (Pacific Time) with the championship finals beginning at 6:45 p.m.
